Steps and Materials Needed to Convert a Collecting Jar to a Killing Jar

If killing and mounting insects is required to meet your educational or collecting goals, the collection bottle can be modified using these instructions

- 1. Open the jar and thoroughly wash and dry. Set the lid aside.
- 2. In a bowl, mix plaster of Paris according to directions on package. Be sure to remove any lumps in the mixture.
- 3. Slowly pour the plaster into the jar to a depth of appproxiately 1/2". Allow the plaster to set overnight.
- 4. Using a dampened cloth, wipe away any excess plaster from the sides of the jar, leaving a smooth surface on the plaster inside the jar.
- 5. Replace the lid and allow the plaster to fully cure according to package directions.
- 6. When cured, open the jar and pour acetone (unscentd nail polish remover) or a high proof 90% isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) to dampen the entire bottom of the jar. Replace the lid.
- 7. Your collecting jar is now transformed into a killing jar.
- 8. Recharge the jar with acetone or isopropyl alcohol as needed.
